Biopsy Wound Care

Please remove the bandage from the biopsy site tomorrow morning. You may shower, bathe, or do anything you wish. You may sw im at any time, but avoid Jacuzzis/Hot tubs until the biopsy site is healed.

Please wash the site daily with soap and water, apply Vaseline/Aquaphor ointment and cover with a bandage until healed. Vaseline or Aquaphor ointment contains very few chemicals and is usually an adequate ointment to keep the biopsy site moist.

The back, shoulders and chest areas are more difficult to heal and sometimes may leave a more thickened scar due to the nature of the locations of the biopsy site. Areas below the knees also take longer to heal.

We will call you with your results of the biopsy in about 7-10 days. If you do not hear from us, by two weeks please call us.
